


SMALL SIGNAL SCHOTTKY DIODE



DESCRIPTION

Metal to silicon junction diode primarly intended for UHF mixers and ultrafast switching applications.

Figure 1. Forward current versus forward voltage at different temperatures (typical values).




Figure 3. Reverse current versus junction temperature.




Figure 2. Forward current versus forward voltage (typical values).






Figure 4. Reverse current versus continuous reverse voltage (typical values).
